

Dear Participants to the Workshop “Contested Spaces”,

This is a letter with practical and hopefully useful information for your stay in Rome. We suggest you print a copy of it and carry with you during the whole period of the workshop.

How to get to the Hotel from the Airport

Once you picked up your luggage in Fiumicino Airport, head to the **train station** following the signs. There is one “**Leonardo Express**” every 30 minutes, that takes you directly to Termini Station, the main train station in Rome, right in the city centre. The ticket costs **14 euros** (one way, you may want to purchase two tickets each, the second one to be stamped when you go back) and you can buy it at the ticket office at the head of the tracks or in any newsagent in the airport. Just ask for “train ticket to Rome”. On the same spot, we recommend you buy also two ordinary **bus tickets** (1.5 euros each) to use on the bus once in Rome. The trip from the airport to Termini Station lasts about **half an hour**.

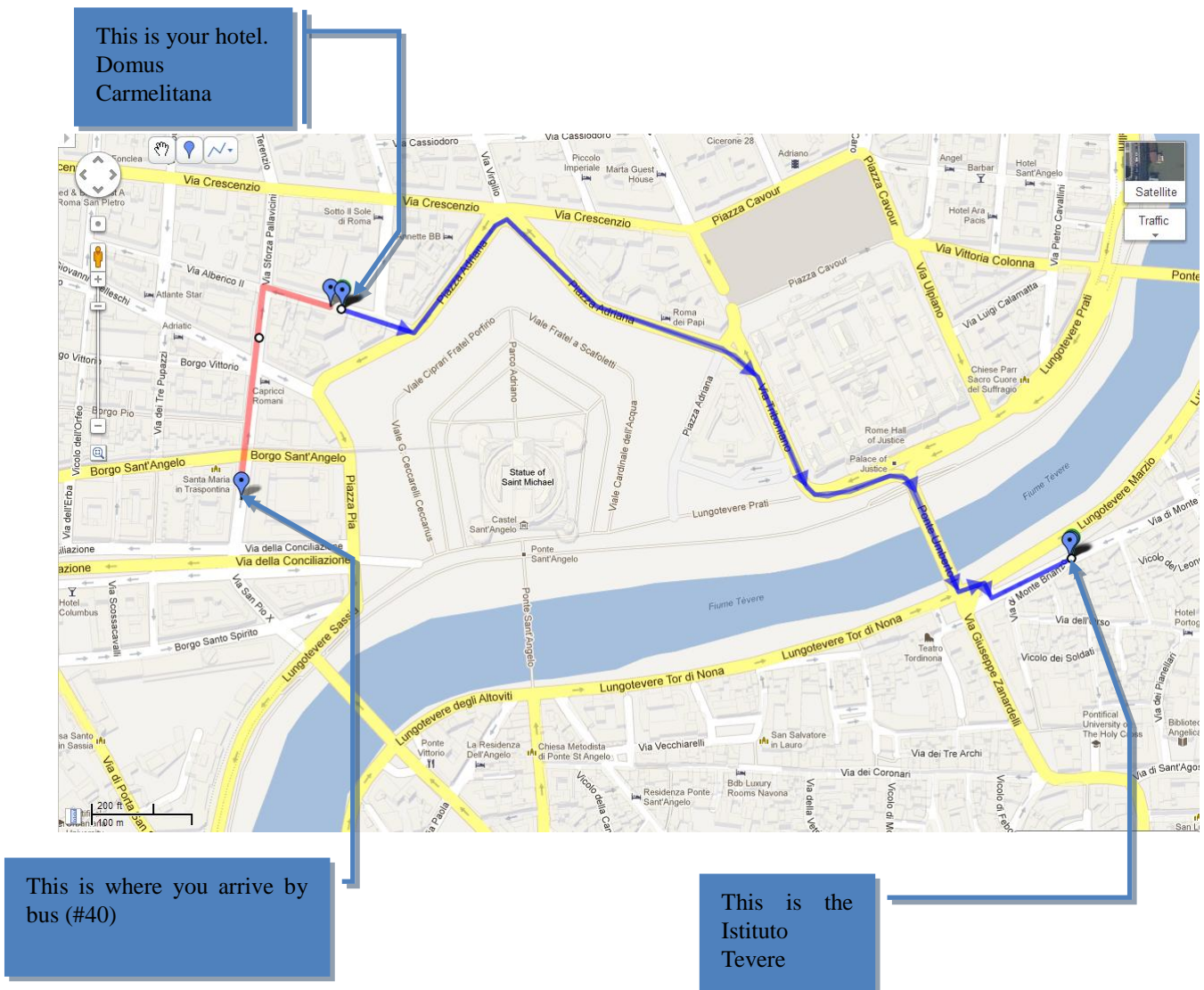
Once you are in Termini, the easiest way to get to the hotel is by bus.

Exit the train station towards “piazza dei Cinquecento”. On the left side of the big square look for the **bus terminal of line 40** (direction piazza Pia/Castel S. Angelo). There is a #40 bus every 6 or 7 minutes, so you shouldn’t wait too long. Jump in on the first available bus and travel for **seven stops**. You get off at the “**conciliazione**” **stop** and you follow the same direction of the bus for 200 meters. Once you reach via Alberico II, turn right and your hotel is some 30 meters ahead on your left hand.

How to get to the Workshop venue from the Hotel

It’s a nice **ten minute walk** and we strongly recommend you enjoy it on foot. No need to catch buses nor cabs, you’re in one of the most beautiful quarters in Rome and we hope you can find refreshing the nice promenade from the place where you stay to the Istituto Tevere, in via di Monte Brianzo 82. You have just to tour around the big “Castel Sant’Angelo” and cross the Tiber on

the Ponte Umberto bridge. Follow the map!
